Joseph was selected to represent New Zealand as a member of the New Zealand Youth Development Kayaking Squad in the U17 age group. He won a silver medal in the K1 individual event, a silver medal in the K1 team's event, and a gold medal in the down-river individual event.

He also won a Silver Medal in the recent North Island Snowboarding Championships.

Challenge Cup
Girls' Sport and Sportsmanship

Megan Hull

Megan is a member of the Wairarapa College 1st XI girls' Hockey Team which won the Federation Cup this year. She was also a member of the U18 Wairarapa Girls' Hockey team that won a silver medal in the Nationals. She was recently selected in the NZ U18 girls' hockey team – an outstanding achievement for a student who is still only 15.

At school she is currently the girls' Junior Athletics Champion and won the Intercollegiate girls' Junior Triple Jump and Long Jump. She is also the school's U15 girls' cross country champion.

She is captain of the Wairarapa College 1st XI Girls' cricket team and a member of the college's successful girls' Basketball team that won the local competition this year. She is also a member of the Wairarapa College Gold Volley ball team that won the regional senior secondary competition.

She is a talented sportswomen and this year's winner of the Challenge Cup – Girls Sport and Sportsmanship.

Alex has represented NZ at the Commonwealth Youth Championships, held in the Isle of Man, in September, coming 4th in his favoured event of Hammer and making the final of the Shot Put finishing 8th. He has also been selected as a member of the first Oceania Region Team to compete at the Australian Athletics Junior Championships in Sydney. He won the under 18 Hammer event and gained a Silver in the under 18 Shot Put and was placed a close 4th in the under 18 discus event.

Alex gained double National Titles at the 2011 Athletics NZ Championships. He won the Mens 16 Hammer event and he gained his second national title in the Mens 16 Shot Put. At the same meeting Alex also won two silver medals in the Mens 16 discus and Mens 19 Hammer events.

He broke Discus and Shot Put records for Wairarapa College on our Athletics Day and at the Wairarapa Region Secondary School Championships. He now holds all the age group records at these meetings in both Discus and Shot Put. Some of those records had previously stood for 40 years.

He is a very talented sportsman and this year's winner of Holmwood Cup – Boys Sport and Sportsmanship.

Special Awards – Each year six special awards are presented at the Senior Prizegiving to Year 13 students. The criteria for each award, with a brief history, is detailed in the 2011 Senior Prize Giving Book.
